## Rules, Regulations & Entry Form

Parade Date: July 1st starting at 9:45 am

ENTRY DEADLINE: June 29th

Parade Assembly area is the parking lot of Aldergrove Community Secondary School, 26850 29 Avenue, Aldergrove

***Parade Route Map is provided ...this is a self guided parade and you are responsible to follow the Motor Vehicle Act regulations and obey all speed limits and traffic lights and signs along the parade route.***

## Rules and Regs

1. **Closing date:** All applications must be signed and received by the deadline noted on the application form.

2. **Age limit:** Minors must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

3. **City by-laws:** By-laws prohibit giving or throwing merchandise or devices of any kind from any float or entry.

4. **Liability:** Sponsors of any entry will indemnify and save harmless the Aldergrove Agricultural Fair & Festival Association, it's directors and employees, Township of Langley and Province of

B.C. from all responsibility for personal injury or property damage arising from accidents incurred going to, during and dispersing from the parade event

5. **Vehicles only - NO WALKING, all participants must be secured and safe within their vehicle.**

6. **Float safety:**

No smoking on or near floats. Carry an approved fire extinguisher (should be dry chemical type; at least 5lbs.). Be sure it is in good working order and people with the float are aware of how to use it.

Be certain the exhaust pipe is wrapped with fire protective insulation where it passes near decorations.

Be sure that the vehicles braking system is in working order and that there is adequate vision and ventilation.

Make certain all vehicles are properly serviced with water, fuel and oil and that the tires and battery are in good condition.

Vehicles will be in the assembly area for some time before the commencement of the parade.

Vehicles must be in good mechanical condition to ensure it can make it through the parade route.

### 7. Starting time

8:45 a.m. Large floats must be checked in

9:15 a.m. All floats must be in line up

9:25 a.m. Bands, marching units and drill teams must be in place

9:45 a.m. Parade starts

Please ensure all people in your group are aware of these rules

8. **Check-in:** Check in will be in the south-east parking lot of the Aldergrove Community Secondary School 26850 29 Avenue. As you enter the parking lot drive to the check in tent and you will be given a location to park. **DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR VEHICLE UNTIL YOU HAVE PARKED IN YOUR DESIGNATED SPOT.** Social distancing regulation apply. A portable washroom and sanitizer will be provided Position numbers will be marked along the assemble area starting with number 1 at the beginning. Parade position numbers will be assigned by Email. Please ensure that all participants are aware of your position number and the name you're registered under. Each Entry will be given their position number printed on a paper plate which will need to be attached to the left side of your entry in clear view for the announcer to see.

9. Your position in the parade: Every effort will be made to position entries in an entertaining and coordinated manner. Your position in the parade is critical. Since the reviewing stand and narrator will rely on our arrangement, you **MUST NOT** change your position. To ensure you are in the correct position, check the numbers ahead and behind you to see that you are in sequence. We count on each participant to assist in keeping the parade in order. If there is a problem advise the check-in immediately.

10. **Keep safe!!** This is a self-guided parade and no roads have been closed so please drive cautiously and obey all Motor Vehicle act regulations. Stop at all stop signs and traffic signals as required.

***Their will be NO walking in the parade on vehicles will be able to participate in the parade.***

11. **Dispersal:** Entries will either immediate disperse following the parade or they may return to the parking lot of Aldergrove Community Secondary School to meet up with parents, etc.

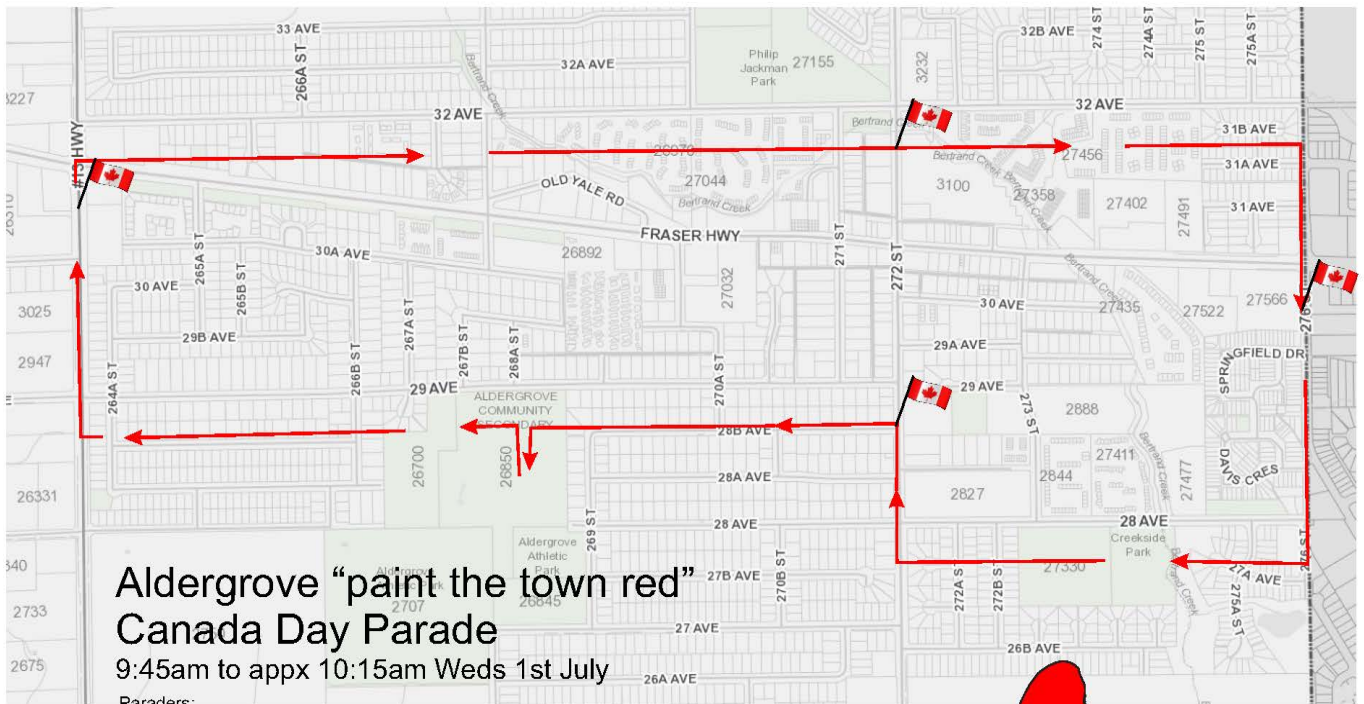

- Paraders:
- Minimum cruising speed 30 kph.
  - Obey all traffic signs and Motor Vehicle Act regulations requirements.
  - **No throwing goodies from the float. Drivers responsible for ensuring all passengers are seated and safely secured.**
  - Please be responsible and wear masks when social distancing is difficult.
  - Wear red!



- Spectators:
- Please stay on the sidewalk.
  - The route is 4 miles so spread out and maintain 2m between family groups.
  - Wear red!
  - Be kind, have fun, be safe.
